Quality Accounts & Reporting

- This audit is included in the Quality Accounts List 2020/21
- The national summary results were presented at the BAUS 2020 Virtual Annual Meeting in November 2020 and uploaded onto the BAUS website in November 2020
- Individual unit feedback was sent to the Clinical Lead for Urology in all participating units to allow benchmarking against the national data and to drive quality improvement
- The audit measured compliance with NICE and EAU guidelines and variation in assessment and treatment, including waiting times and indications for surgery across the UK

Data Collection

- Data was collected on all men undergoing intervention for BOO (including PAE) during November 2019
- Data submission took place between 1 April and 30 June (the initial data collection period of 1 month was extended owing to the COVID-19 pandemic)
- Data collection was retrospective to allow entry of follow-up data (if normal practice in the unit)
- Anonymised unit level data only was collected
- 1456 datasets were captured from 105 hospitals (see below), including hospitals in Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland
