

The Cambridge Surgical Skills Emergency Urology Course 21st & 22nd May 2024

A practical course: delegates will have hands on experience of a range of emergency urological surgical techniques using fresh frozen cadavers, in a simulated operating environment with experienced faculty.

Emergency Urology Procedures:

- Approach to the kidney for emergency nephrectomy
- Ureteric injury repair: end-to end ureteric anastomosis; Psoas hitch and Boari flap re-implantations
- Fournier's gangrene debridement
- Scrotal exploration, testicular rupture repair, orchidopexy
- Andrology: penile blocks, dorsal slit, priapism, penile fracture
- Open cystotomy and insertion of SPC
- Bladder repair

ST3-7 level doctors and updates for consultant level with priority for ST5-7 and equivalent level doctors in training.
