HOME PAGE

When you access the BAUS 2020 platform via the web or mobile app you will be directed to the home page.

On your home page you will find posts from the organisers throughout the meeting, highlighting when key sessions are about to begin and other important information.

AGENDA

Programme & details of sessions taking place on 9-11 November. Sessions can be filtered by subspeciality using the colour coded tabs.

The agenda is where you will be able to watch sessions on their given date & time, participate in Q&A, leave a comment and give your instant feedback on the session.
