## BRITISH ASSOCIATION OF UROLOGICAL SURGEONS

THE Fifteenth Annual General Meeting (combined meeting with the Canadian Urological Association) was held at the Royal Faculty of Physicians and Surgeons, 242 St Vincent Street, Glasgow, on Thursday, 16th July 1959, at 9.30 A.M.

The President, Mr Arthur Jacobs, was in the Chair.

- 1. Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on 19th June 1958 were read and signed as correct.
- 2. - 3. Report of the Council for 1958-59.—The report of the Council for 1958-59, which had been circulated, was received and adopted.
- 4. Report of the Honorary Treasurer and Balance-sheet at 31st December 1958.—The audited accounts for the year 1958, which showed a surplus on the year's working of £459. 0s. 6d., were presented by the Honorary Treasurer and approved.
- 5. Election of Officers.—The following were elected Officers for 1959-60: *President*, Mr David Band; *Immediate Past President*, Mr Arthur Jacobs; *Vice-President*, Professor L. N. Pyrah; *Honorary Treasurer*, Professor V. W. Dix; *Honorary Secretary*, Mr J. D. Fergusson; *Honorary Editorial Secretary*, Mr N. M. Matheson.
- 6. Election of Members of Council.—The following were elected Members of Council to fill the vacancies: Mr B. H. Page, Mr F. P. Raper, Mr W. K. Yeates, Mr D. M. Wallace (to fill casual vacancy caused by Professor Pyrah's election as Vice-President).
  - 7. Election of Auditors.—Messrs Howard, Howes & Co. were re-elected auditors for the ensuing year.
- 8. 1960 Annual Meeting.—The President reported that the 1960 Annual Meeting would be held in London on 23rd, 24th and 25th June and that the main subject for discussion would be "Calculous Disease in the Upper Urinary Tract."
- 9. **1961 Annual Meeting.**—The President reported that the main discussion at the 1961 Annual Meeting would be on the "Neurogenic Bladder."
  - 10. Rules.—The following Resolution was passed:—
    - "That the subjoined new Rule to be numbered 16A be added to the Rules of the Association.
    - "16A. Investment.

The Council may invest the moneys of the Association not immediately required for the purposes thereof in or upon any investment for the time being authorised by law for the investment of trust funds or in the debentures, debenture stock bonds or other marketable securities and the stocks and shares of any description of any public corporation or authority or of any Company whose shares are quoted on the London Stock Exchange and which has an issued capital of not less than £100,000."

On Wednesday evening, 15th July, members of the British and Canadian Urological Associations and their guests were invited by the President and Council of the Royal Faculty of Physicians and Surgeons to a Reception. This was followed by a Buffet-Supper.

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Members of both Associations were invited by the Board of Management to lunch at the Glasgow Royal Infirmary.

In the afternoon the meeting was continued in the Lister Lecture Theatre, Royal Infirmary, and the following short papers were given:—

- 4. "Urethroplasties." Dr L. R. Williams (Vancouver).

Following the papers, members and their guests attended a Civic Reception by the Lord Provost and Magistrates of the City of Glasgow.

The Annual Dinner was held in the evening at the Grosvenor Restaurant and was attended by 156 members and their guests. During the Dinner the St Peter's Medal was presented to Professor L. N. Fyrah.

On Friday morning, 17th July, a discussion was held on "Hydronephrosis," the openers being: Professor V. W. Dix, Mr G. F. Murnaghan, Mr Howard G. Hanley, Dr John Balfour, Mr R. H. O. B. Robinson.

In the afternoon an Excursion was held to Loch Lomond and members were entertained to tea at Rossdhu, the residence of Sir Ivor Colguboun.
