## BRITISH ASSOCIATION OF UROLOGICAL SURGEONS

THE Sixteenth Annual General Meeting was held at the Royal College of Surgeons, Lincoln's Inn Fields, London, W.C.2, on Thursday, 23rd June 1960, at 9.30 A.M.

The President, Mr David Band, was in the Chair.

- 1. Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on 16th July 1959 were read and signed as correct.
