`MINUTES OF THE ELEVENTH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE BRITISH ASSOCIATION OF UROLOGICAL SURGEONS LIMITED

Tuesday 29 September 2020 at 08.00 am

Explanatory Note: The BAUS Annual General Meeting is normally held during the BAUS Annual Scientific Meeting. In 2020, the Annual Scientific Meeting will be held virtually in November due to COVID19. BAUS is required to hold an AGM in 2020.

Therefore, the Trustees agreed to convene an AGM under the provisions of Schedule 14 of the Corporate Insolvency and Governance Act 2020 which assists companies with the constitutional problems caused by lockdown. The provisions allowed companies to delay a general meeting up to 30 September 2020 and apply temporary relaxations to the manner in which the meeting is to be held.

The temporary relaxations meant that:

- the meeting (AGM) need not be held at any particular place.
- -the meeting may be held, and any votes may be permitted to be cast, by electronic means or any other means.
- the meeting may be held without any number of those participating in the meeting being together at the same place.
- a member of the qualifying body does not have a right—
 - (a)to attend the meeting in person,

5. TRUSTEES' ANNUAL REPORT AND FINANCIAL STATEMENTS 2019

The Trustees' Annual Report and Financial Statements 2019 were received. It was noted the full documents were available from the BAUS website.

Unanimously approved.

6. REPORT FROM THE HONORARY TREASURER

a. Accounts for the Financial Year ending 31 December 2019

The summary of the accounts for the year ending 31 December 2019 were received and were available on the BAUS website.

Unanimously approved.

The Honorary Treasurer (Mr Olly Wiseman) gave a short presentation on the BAUS finances. He presented a graph showing BAUS income vs expenditure which showed the potential threat of an unsustainable deficit of £176k – which, if unchecked, would mean BAUS would cease to exist in 10 years. While BAUS continued to hold reserves of £2.8 million (as at December 2019), the Trustees were working hard to address the deficit position. Measures included including undertaking a membership review, an income review, an investment review and a proposed increase in member subscriptions (see Minute 6b below). The investment review resulted in funds being transferred to CCLA Investment Management and the portfolio had continued to perform well in a turbulent market. BSOT had transferred funds of £53,668 to BAUS in August 2019 and the new Section held its first meeting in February 2020.

Mr Wiseman outlined key challenges facing the Trustees – including declining surpluses from Annual Scientific Meeting. The surplus for the ASM in November 2020 was projected to be £91k (which was similar to 2019). This was in contrast to previous surpluses - £292k in 2016, £169k in 2017 and £226k in 2018. COVID had disrupted plans for all BAUS meetings in 2020; it had not been possible to hold the Annual Meetings of the Sections of Endourology and Oncology which, in 2019, had generated surpluses of £32k and £14k respectively. However, counterbalancing a fall in income, Committee and Presidential expenses were lower in 2020 because of restrictions on travel.

Teaching had been moved on line during the course of the year – including the FRCS (Urol) Revision Course – and BAUS had also launched a new webinar series earlier in the month which was free to members.

BAUS continued to be very grateful to its industry partners for their support during 2020 – both through sponsorship of the virtual Annual Scientific Meeting as well as through a new venture – commercial webinars.

Mr Wiseman was pleased that no BAUS staff had been furloughed and the annual audit had been successfully completed during the period of lockdown – which was a tribute to the hard work of Mrs Linda Sizer, Finance Manager.

Looking to the future, the Trustees would continue to scrutinize expenditure as well as seek to offer increased value and benefits to BAUS members.

In closing, Mr Wiseman expressed his thanks to Mr Nick Watkin (Treasurer Elect), Miss Patricia Hagan (Deputy CEO), Mrs Sizer, the BAUS Office Team and the Trustees for their support over the past (very challenging) year.

b. Retiring Trustees

Mr Duncan Summerton, Leicester General Hospital (President). The President thanked Mr Summerton (who was in attendance at the AGM) for the work he had done during his period of tenure. The President also congratulated Mr Summerton on his recent election as President of the FSSA.

Unanimously approved.

10. REPORT ON ELECTION OF REGIONAL MEMBERS OF COUNCIL

It was noted that Trustees had confirmed the election of Regional Council Members with effect from 26 June 2020 as follows:

North East – Mr David Thomas (Freeman Hospital, Newcastle upon Tyne) had completed his second term of office. There was one candidate and Mr Mark Johnson (Freeman Hospital, Newcastle upon Tyne) will serve his first term of office (2020-2023).

Kent, Surrey and Sussex – Professor Sri Sriprasad (Darent Valley Hospital, Dartford) had completed his second term of office. There was one candidate and Mr Stephen Garnett (Eastbourne District General Hospital) will serve his first term of office (2020-2023).

The President expressed his thanks to the demitting Council members. He also thanked Mr Thomas (who was a co-opted Trustee of BAUS as well as being a Regional Council Member) for his very effective contributions to discussions at meetings of the Board.

11. AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

The President summarised the background to the proposed changes to the Articles of Association. These had also been set out in the information circulated to voting members with the Notice for the AGM.

The BAUS governing documents were last reviewed and updated in 2006 when BAUS became a company limited by guarantee. Since that time there had been updates to the Companies Act and other legislative changes (such as age discrimination legislation and proxy voting) which necessitated modifications to the BAUS Articles of Association. In addition to these technical updates, the BAUS Trustees were also taking the opportunity to amend the Articles to enable the following changes to be implemented in due course:

- The potential to extend the membership of BAUS to include other members of the
 urological team (currently membership was limited to Medical Practitioners). BAUS
 members had approved the principle of expanding the membership pool at the AGM in
 2012. The proposed amendments to the Articles would give effect to this, although
 detailed provisions for any changes to membership categories would be subject to
 consultation and a vote at a future AGM on amended Rules.
- In June 2020, the President had outlined plans to appoint the first non-urological Trustees in 2021 in his Presidential address. This change had been under discussion by the Board for some time and it was felt lay trustees would give "a chance to bring much needed skills to the mix" as all the trustees were currently clinicians. There were other areas of expertise that could be beneficial to the Board in its debates including IT / digital, finance, HR etc. The Articles had been amended to make provision for lay Trustees.
- The COVID-19 pandemic had thrown up many challenges and it was undoubtedly the case that the way meetings were conducted in the future would change. While the Articles were being updated the opportunity had been taken to include provision for General Meetings of the Association to be held by virtual means as opposed to requiring only face to face meetings.

The President confirmed that the Trustees unanimously supported these changes being brought to the AGM.

A full copy of the amended Articles, and a copy with all the changes highlighted, had been circulated to all voting members and were available on the BAUS website. Members had been given the opportunity to send questions or comments about these changes to the Chief Executive in advance of the meeting.

The meeting was asked to consider revised Articles of Association. The votes were cast as follows:

105 voted in support of the Special Resolution and 4 voted against – so the Special Resolution was passed as follows:

IT WAS RESOLVED THAT the draft articles attached to this resolution be approved and adopted as the Articles of Association of the Company in substitution for and to the exclusion of all the existing Articles of the Company.
