

Emergency Urology Surgical Skills course 15th April 2026

A one-day practical course where delegates will have hands on experience of a range of emergency urological surgical techniques using fresh frozen cadavers, in a simulated operating environment with experienced faculty.

Course content

- Renal trauma: emergency exploration and nephrectomy
- Approach to the ureter and anastomotic ureteric repair (end- to-end)
- Ureteric re-implantation techniques: psoas hitch and Boari flap
- Penile fracture and urethral injury repair
- Testicular torsion, testicular rupture & orchidectomy

Additional Educational Elements

- Short lecture on the surgical steps for each skill including important anatomy
- Tuition from experienced faculty, and use of surgical instruments and materials

Learning Outcomes

- Understanding and technical skills of emergency urology surgery
- Anatomy relevant to emergency surgery
