



MEDICAL STUDENT ESSAY COMPETITION 2021

Medical students are invited to submit a 1500-word essay titled:

"How has COVID-19 changed undergraduate Urology teaching? What innovations have been most successful? Has anything been lost?"

Word limit: 1500 maximum excluding title, abstract (no more than 200 words) and references. The word count **includes** words used in figures & figure captions, tables, appendices, footers and in-text citations. **It is important to read the full Guidance Notes for full information on the format of the essay.** Essays may not be accepted if they do not meet the required format.

Students must be an undergraduate enrolled at a medical school in either England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland or the Republic of Ireland at the closing date – see below. Entries from students attending a medical school in overseas countries will not be eligible. The author of the essay judged to be the most outstanding in each medical school will receive a prize certificate and entered into the national competition.

The prize for the winner of the national competition will be £750 and the prize for the runner up in the national competition will be £500. The national winner and runner up will be presented with their certificates at the BAUS Annual Conference and BAUS will give guest registration for the conference.
